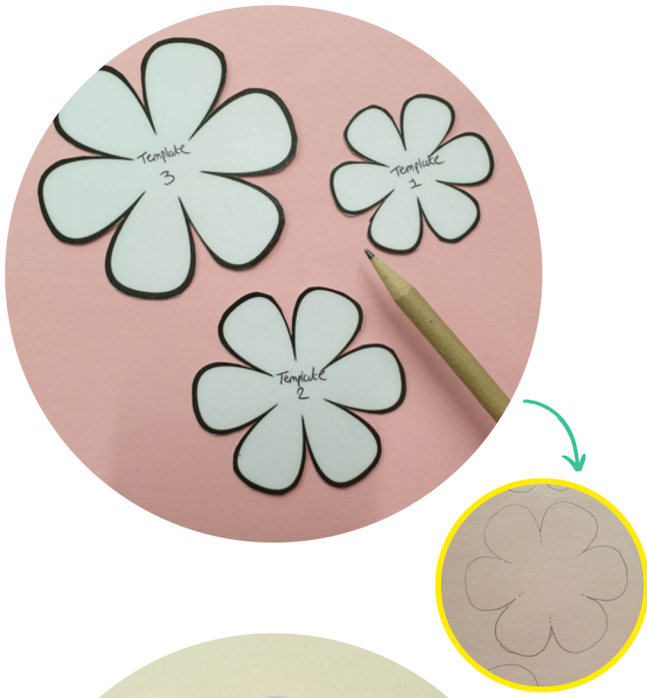


PAPER FLOWERS

STEP 1

Choose plain (non-patterned) coloured card/paper for your flower, and select three flower templates of different sizes. To make small flowers, use templates 1 to 3. For larger flowers, use templates 3 to 5. (Templates can be found on the final page).



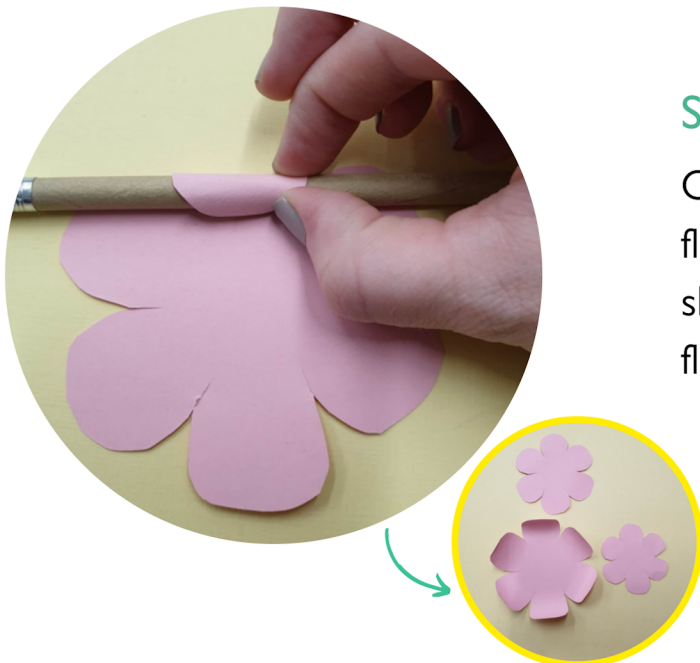
STEP 2

Cut out your templates, place on the paper/card and use a pencil to draw around them. Alternatively, trace the template outlines onto your paper. Remove the template/tracing paper and cut out your three paper flowers with a pair of scissors.



STEP 3 (OPTIONAL)

One by one, gently curl the petals of your flower around a pencil to make them slightly raised. Curl all six petals on all three flowers.



PAPER FLOWERS CONT



STEP 4

Using a small amount of glue (or a single glue dot) in the centre, secure your three flowers together in size order.



STEP 5

Create a centre for your flower by gluing down a few scrunched up balls of tissue paper.



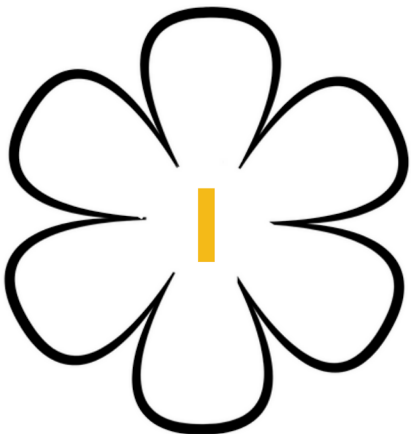
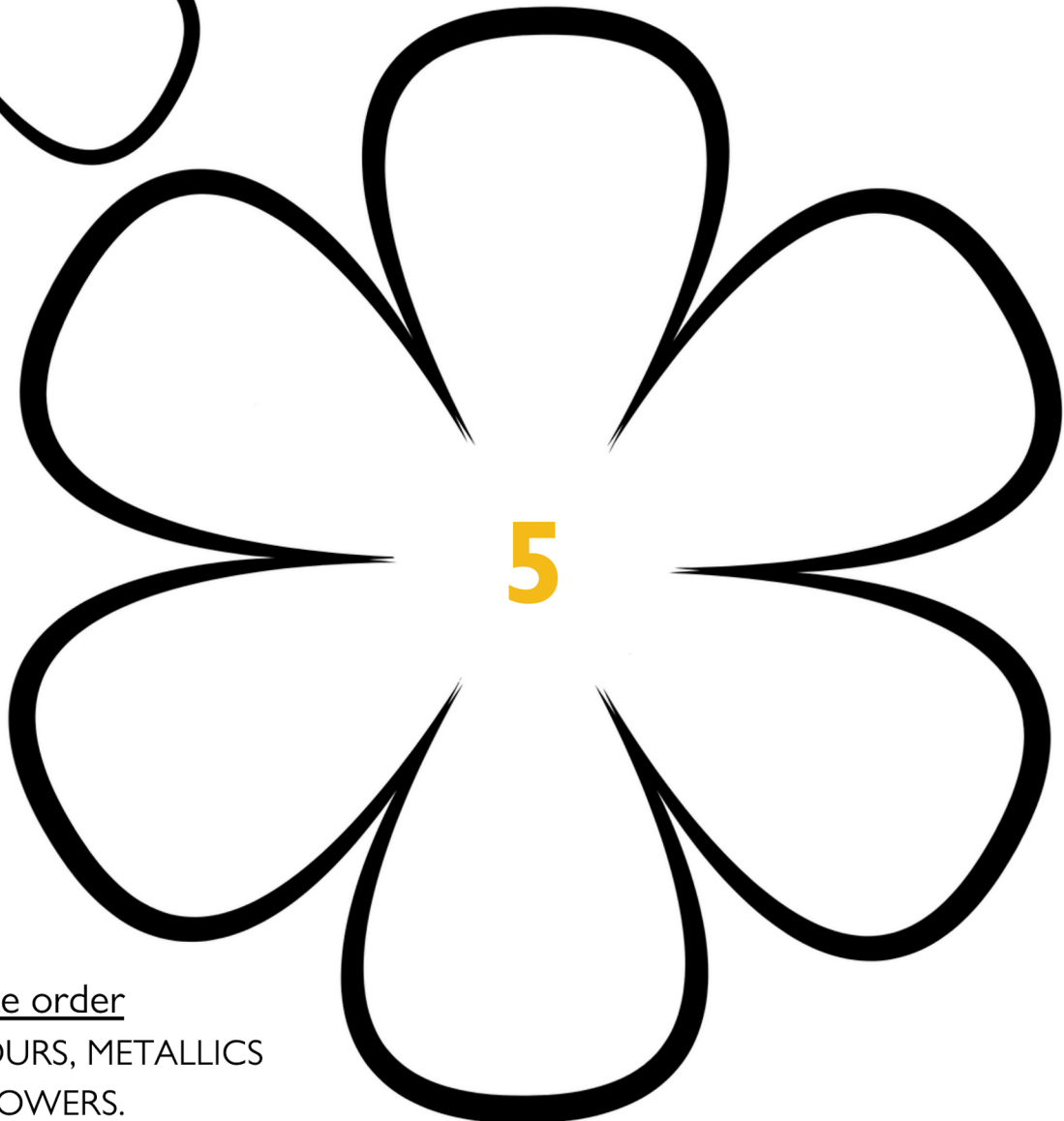
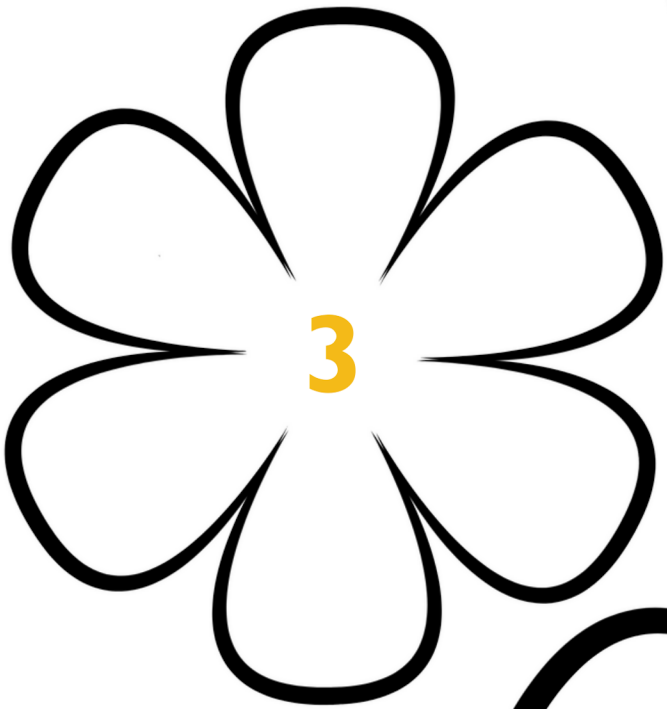
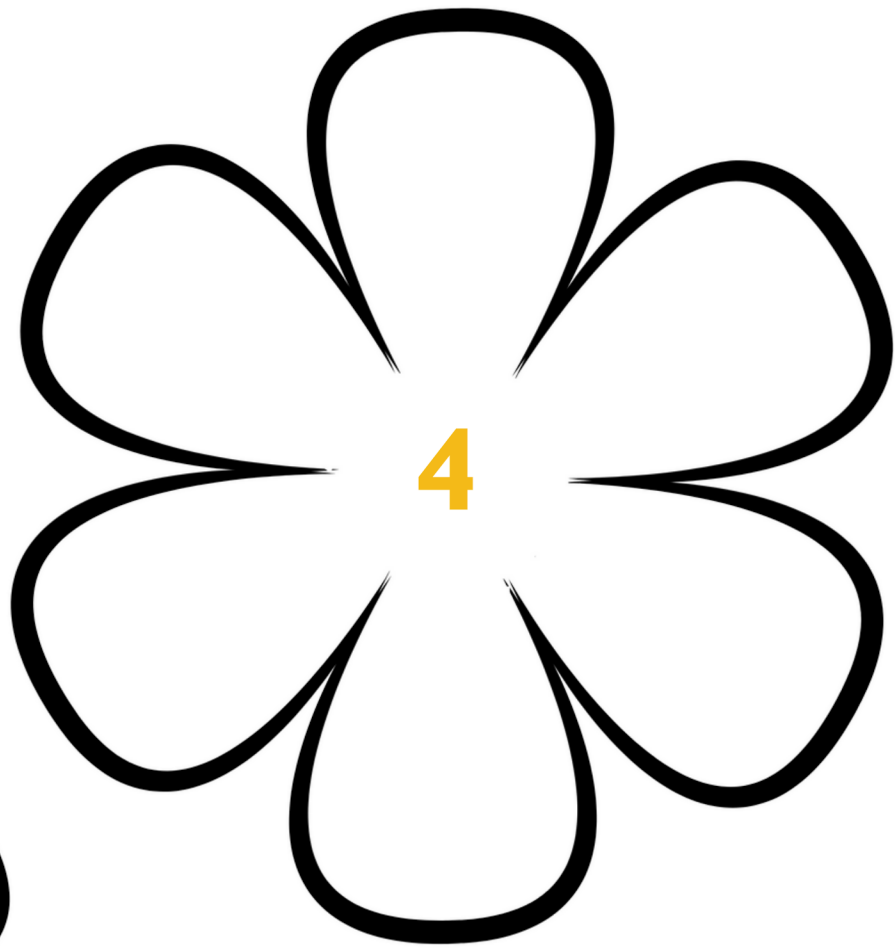
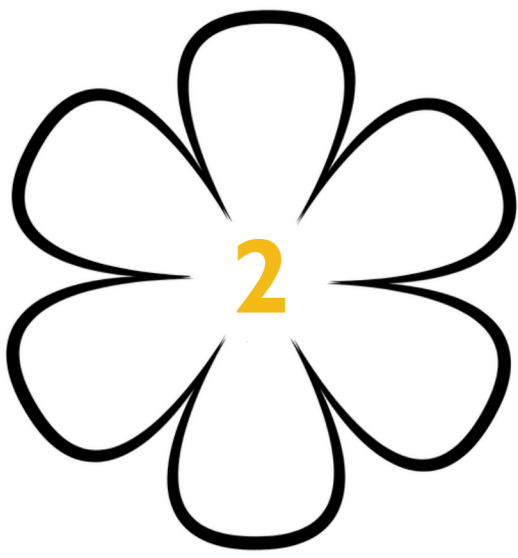
STEP 6
